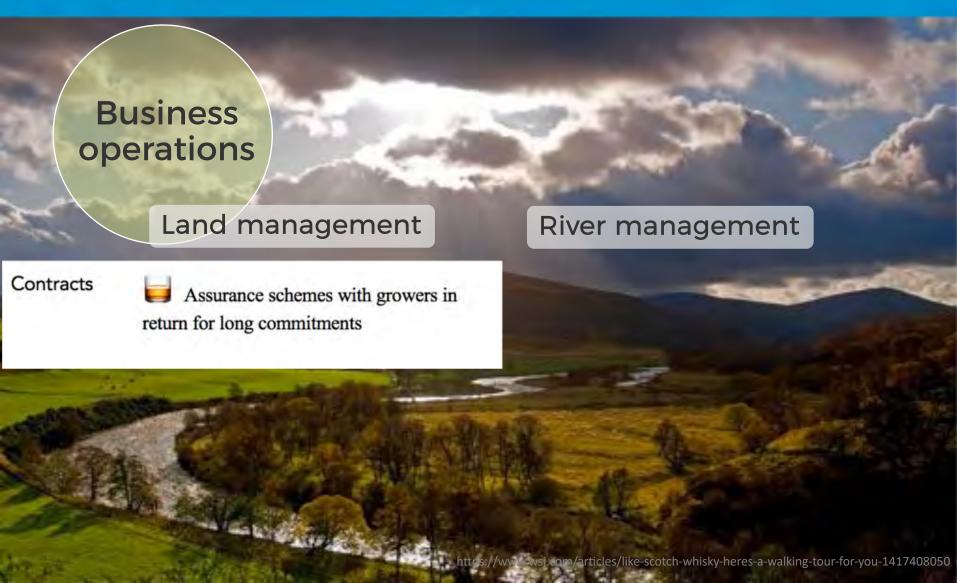

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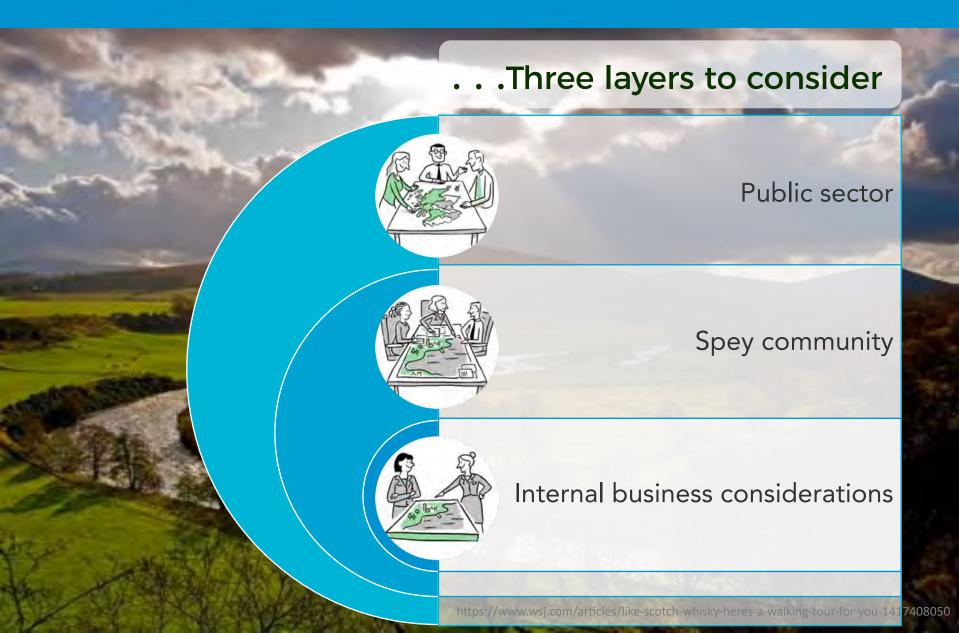

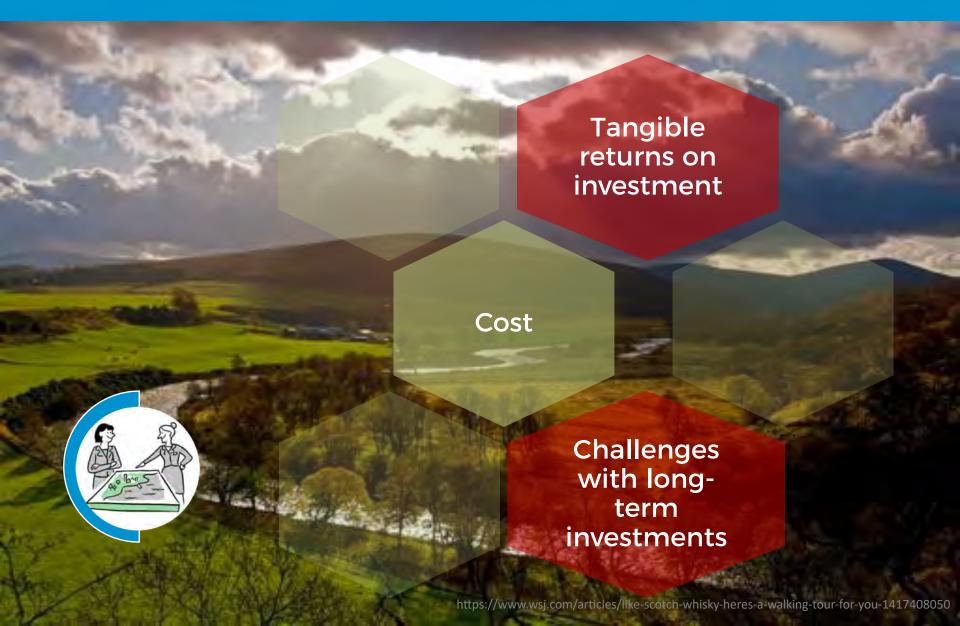

### Motivation A: The investor is dependent and connected with the land



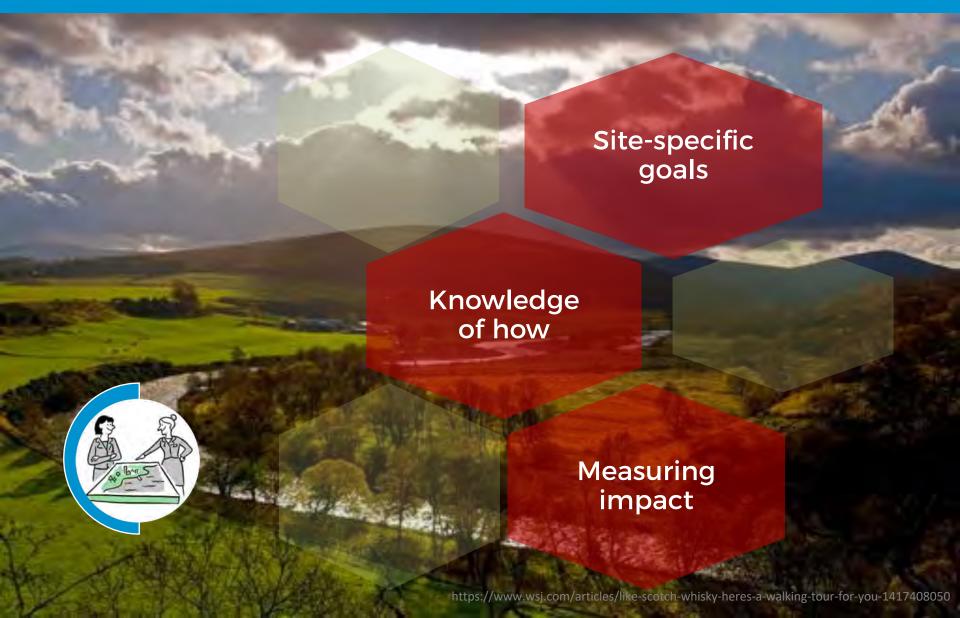

### Motivation F: The business is having an impact on the landscape

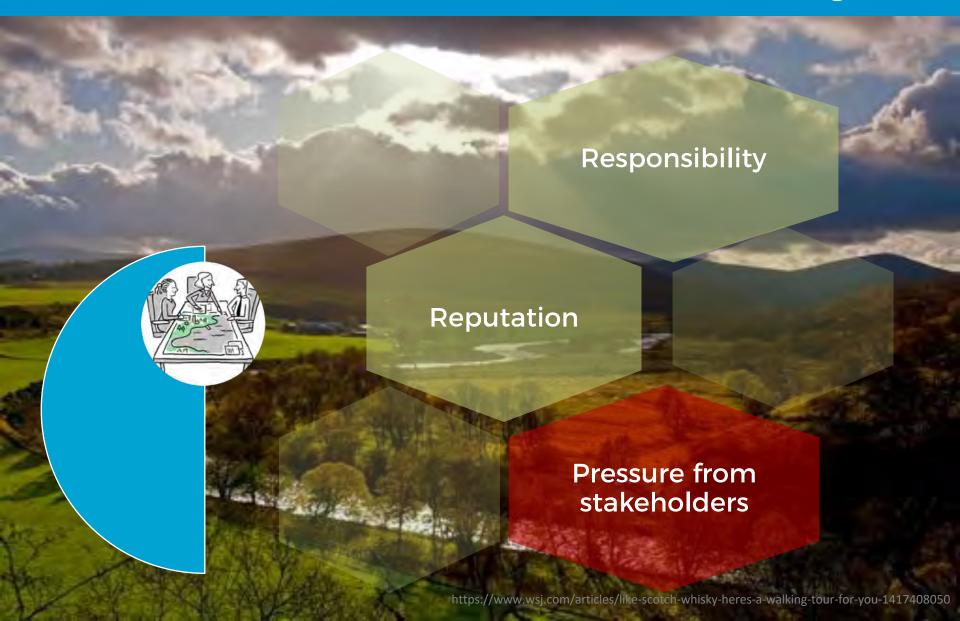

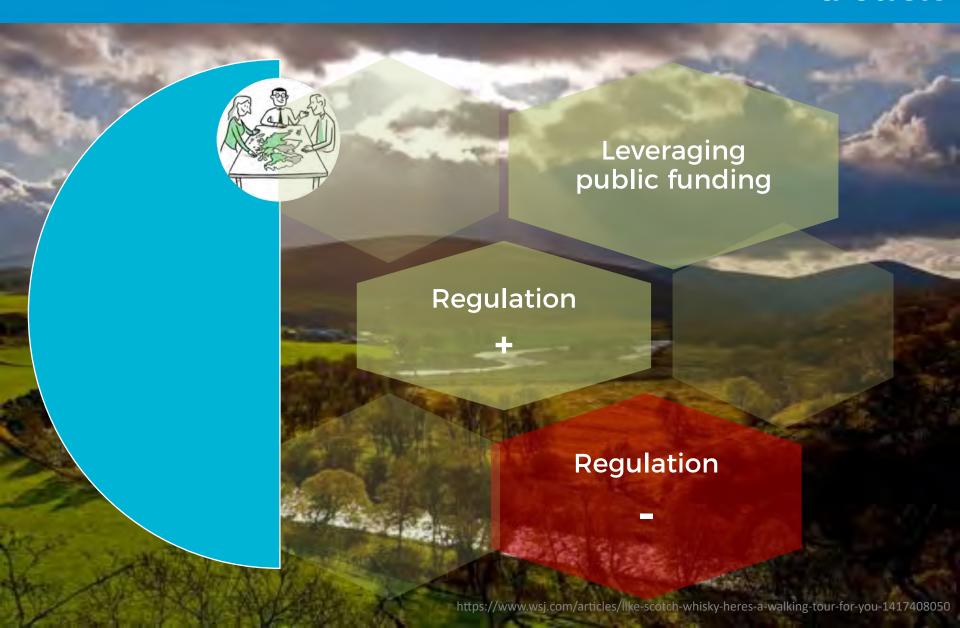
With biodiversity it seems much harder to set down a clear benchmark and understand in clear terms what we want to achieve"

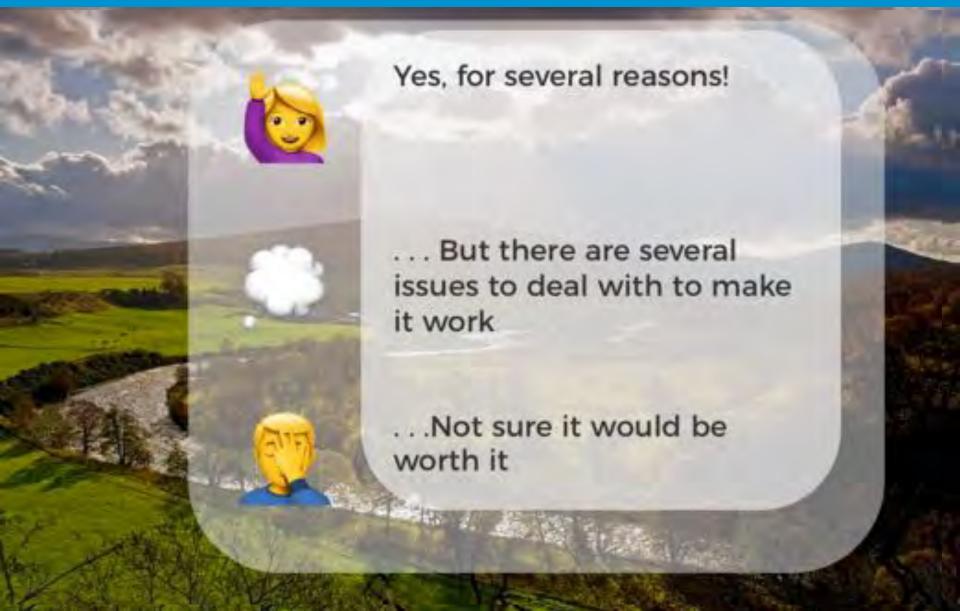
